**The monthly monitoring report on demolitions and Israeli violations against Palestinian homes
and installations**

For the period

1/12 – 31/12/2020

This report aims to monitor violations by the Israeli occupation forces against Palestinian homes and installations, which include demolitions, evictions, confiscations, or various notifications. The report was prepared according to field information monitored by the staff and researchers of the Center for Human Rights and Democracy Media Center "SHAMS", for the period between 11/1/2020 - 31/11/2020, and it is the outcome of the relevant monitoring efforts carried out by the "SHAMS" Center staff in the geographical scope represented by the West Bank, including East Jerusalem.



- **December general statistic**

During the month of December 2020, the "SHAMS" Center monitored the Israeli occupation forces targeting (120) facilities owned by Palestinians, whether through demolition, confiscation, eviction, or the distribution of notices with the intention to target these facilities in the future.

The most prominent violations centered on demolitions, which affected 59 facilities. (7) Of them, their owners were forced to self-demolish them under threat of fines and imprisonment. Meanwhile, the occupation forces confiscated and seized (5) facilities. (3) of them were mobile homes (caravans) in the village of Zif in Hebron governorate, owned by citizens: Jamal Radwan Al-Qawasmeh, Mahmoud Abu Asbeih, and Rami Al-Muhtaseb. They also confiscated 2 facilities near the main street north of Huwara town: an iron and tin kiosk for selling coffee (An area of **8 square meters**, owned by: Abd al-Fattah Damidi, and a caravan made of iron and tin, his owner intended to use it as a car wash, its area is **24** square meters, owned by Jamal Khader Odeh, on the pretext of its illegal presence in Area C.

In addition, the Israeli Magistrate's Court issued a decision to evacuate the houses of the citizens Jawad Abu Nab and Salem Ghaith in Batn al-Hawa neighborhood in Silwan for the benefit of the settlers under the pretext that it has been owned by Jews from Yemen since 1881. The property of Salem Ghaith consists of two floors and 10 people live in it, as for the property of Jawad Abu Nab consists of one apartment, the surroundings of which were previously controlled and part of it was turned into a synagogue.

In terms of notifications, the occupation forces notified (54) facilities for demolition, confiscation, or eviction, most of them are residential, in addition to other commercial and agricultural facilities.

Within this, the occupation forces took measurements of the house of prisoner Muhammad Qabha in the village of Tura, west of Jenin, and demanded that it be evacuated, in preparation for demolishing it at any moment, and they also

carried out digging operations in its pillars, after evacuating it from its residents and gathering them in his father's house on the first floor.

- **Distribution of the targeted establishments according to their type**

The facilities that have been targeted with different types of violations, whether by demolition, confiscation, eviction, or notifications, are distributed according to the following:

- **Distribution of facilities targeted for demolition according to the governorates**

As for the geographical distribution of demolitions according to the regional indicator, the peak of the targeting was in Jerusalem governorate, with (17) facilities that were demolished, followed by Hebron governorate with (15) facilities and then Jericho and Jordan Valley governorate, with (9) facilities that were demolished. Note that the facility includes any type of what is mentioned in Table No. (1). Where "SHAMS" Center monitored the demolitions according to the governorates in which they took place as follows:

- **Distribution of facilities targeted by notifications according to the governorates**

In view of the notifications, whether of demolition, confiscation, eviction, or stopping construction work and other violations that prevent Palestinians from realizing their right to build, reconstruct and invest their facilities, the number of notifications reached (54) notifications in different regions this month. The notifications indicate the directions of the upcoming Israeli targeting of Palestinian establishments, and the governorates of Hebron and Jenin came in the highest percentage, followed by Nablus governorate according to the following table:

- **The target population**

since these operations that target Palestinian facilities do not take place in an isolated area from the population. The number of people affected by it during the month of December reached (77) person at least, including a large number of children, reaching (27) children, and a number of women, reaching (7) women, the groups that suffer most in these cases.

- **Arguments for violations**

As for the arguments used by "Israel", the occupying power, in its attempt to legalize the crime. In December, the number of facilities that were demolished under the pretext of building without a permit in Areas C reached (54) establishments out of (59) facilities that were demolished. (3) facilities were targeted under the pretext of harassment on the main road through which settlers pass, and (2) Under the pretext of its proximity to the settlement bypass line.

As for the notifications, most of them were under the pretext of not licensing and building in areas (c), and a facility that was notified under the pretext that it was located in an archaeological area. In addition to the occupation forces taking measurements of the house of prisoner Muhammad Qabha in the village of Tura, west of Jenin, and demanded that it be evacuated, in preparation for demolishing it in any moment, under the pretext of taking action against the occupation.

With regard to the evacuation of the houses of citizens Jawad Abu Nab and Salem Ghaith in Batn Al-Hawa neighborhood in Silwan for the benefit of

settlers, it was under the pretext of its ownership of Jews from Yemen since 1881. As for the seizure and confiscation of the facilities, they were under the pretext of their illegal presence and lack of license

- **Self-demolition**

By focusing on self-demolition, which represents a type of complex and centralized oppression. Whereby Palestinian citizens, the vast majority of whom are Jerusalemites (Men & Women), are forced to demolish their houses and facilities by their own hands, under threat of imposing heavy fines on them and bearing the cost of demolition doubled in case they did not do so. The previous approach of the Israeli forces is a striking identification with the tools of the racist Israeli system from courts, local bodies, army and police forces, and constitutes a crime in which victims are forced to participate in its execution against themselves.

During the month of December, the number of establishments that the occupation authorities forced their owners to self-demolish reached (7), most of them in Silwan neighborhood of Jerusalem, distributed among five houses, including a house owned by a woman, in addition to a commercial store and a barrack for raising livestock. In Silwan neighborhood of Jerusalem, the occupation authorities forced the family of Shahira Ghaith, to demolish her house herself, after notifying her earlier, in order to avoid paying heavy fines in case the occupation authorities carried out the demolition, under the pretext of not being licensed, and she has 5 children, 3 girls and two boys, the eldest is 18 years old, and the youngest is 11 years old.

In Silwan neighborhood of Jerusalem, the occupation authorities forced the family of the citizen: Mahmoud Khaled Al-Khalis to demolish their home on the pretext of not having a permit. Later, it forced the two brothers: Muhammad Al-Khalis and Mahmoud Al-Khalis to demolish their houses (two apartments) on the pretext of not being licensed. This was repeated with the citizen Ali Ruwaidi in Silwan neighborhood of Jerusalem, who has demolished a barrack for raising livestock by himself and its area is about **145** square meters, under the pretext of not being licensed.

In Jabal Al Mukaber neighborhood in Jerusalem, the occupation authorities forced: Fawaz Abdu, to personally demolish his house, under the pretext of not being licensed. Citizen Mounir Eweissat also demolished his commercial store in Schools Street in Jabal Al Mukaber town, southeast of occupied East Jerusalem, in implementation of the Israeli occupation Municipality's decision, and its area is about **35** square meters, claiming that it was not licensed.
