**Monthly Observatory Report on Israeli Occupation's violations Against Palestinian Owned
Facilities and Houses**

on the period of 1st of Nov 2021 to 30th

This report is for the purposes of monitoring violations by the Israeli occupation forces against Palestinian homes and facilities, which include demolitions, evictions, confiscations or various notifications. The report was prepared according to the field information monitored by the staff and researchers of the Center for Human Rights and Democracy Media "Shams", for the period between 1/11/2021-30/11/2021, and it is the outcome of the relevant monitoring efforts carried out by the staff of the "SHAMS" Center in the geographical scope of the West Bank, including East Jerusalem.



Statistics of Nov, 2021

During the month of November 2021, “SHAMS” Center monitored the Israeli occupation forces targeting (216) Palestinian-owned facilities, whether through demolition, confiscation, or distributing notifications with the intention of targeting these facilities in the future.

The most prominent violations were concentrated in the demolitions of (107) facilities, (5) of which the owners were forced to self-demolish them under threat of fines and imprisonment. The occupation authorities in the Jabal Mukaber

neighborhood in Jerusalem forced the citizen Aziz Owaisat to demolish his house himself, and the occupation authorities in the town of Beit Hanina forced the Nashashibi family to demolish their two-story house themselves, and forced the occupation authorities in the Wadi Homs area in the village Sur Baher, Mohammed Khaled Rabay'a, to demolish his house by himself. The occupation authorities in Ras Al-Amoud neighborhood in Jerusalem forced Iyad Burqan to demolish his 350-square-meter, two-story house (under construction), and the occupation authorities forced the citizen Amir Rabaia, from the town of Jabal Mukaber in Jerusalem, decided to demolish his house himself, under the pretext of not having a license. the occupation forces confiscated one facility in the Al-Maarjat area in Jericho governorate, (a container) owned by Suleiman Musa Mleihat.

The occupation forces have notified (108) facilities of demolition, suspension of work or eviction, most of which are residential, in addition to animal pens, agricultural, medical and commercial facilities, and stores.

- **Categorization of Facilities Based on their Type**

- **The distribution of facilities targeted with demolition based on their location with respect to the governorates.**

As for the geographical distribution of demolitions according to the regional indicator, the peaks of targeting were in the Jerusalem governorates (46) facilities, followed by Hebron (29) facilities, and then Tubas (17) facilities. Note that the facility includes any type of what is mentioned in Table No. (1). Where "SHAMS" Center monitored the demolitions according to the governorates in which they took place as follows:

- **The distribution of facilities targeted with notifications based on their location with respect to the governorates.**

Reviewing notifications, whether of demolition or halting construction work and other violations that prevent Palestinians from completing their right to build, reconstruct and invest their facilities, the number of notifications reached (108) notifications in different areas. The notifications indicate trends revealing the orientations of the upcoming Israeli targeting of Palestinian facilities, and the governorates of Jerusalem and Bethlehem came first, according to the following table:

- **Target population**

Since these operations targeting Palestinian facilities do not take place in an isolated area from the population, the number of the affected population during the month of November reached at least (162) persons, including (46) children and (3) women, according to what was available from information.

As for the arguments used by "Israel, in its attempt to legitimize the crime - in the month of November, the facilities that were demolished by the occupying forces under the pretext of building without a permit in Area C were (106) out of (107), and one facility under the pretext of settlers' ownership of the land on which construction is built. The occupation authorities demolished a commercial facility in

the town of Beit Hanina, north of Jerusalem, in preparation for the confiscation of the land and eviction for the settlers, on the pretext of its ownership of the land.

As for the notifications, (89) out of (108) establishments were notified, under the pretext of non-licensing and that they are located in areas (c). and (12) facilities under the pretext of building in an archaeological area. The occupation authorities distributed 12 demolition notices for agricultural rooms in the village of Azzun Atma, south of Qalqilya, including a notice that gave the owner of the agricultural facility 96 hours only on the pretext of building in an archaeological area, and (7) facilities on the pretext that the land is owned by a settlement company. The occupation forces handed 7 Palestinian families living in Kobaniya Umm Haroun, west of Sheikh Jarrah neighborhood, north of the Old City of occupied East Jerusalem, eviction notices from their homes, on the pretext that the land and property on it are owned by a settlement company.

As for the facility that was seized and confiscated, it was under the pretext of not having a license.

- **Self-demolition**

Self-demolition represents a particular type of systemic and concentrated subjugation. Palestinian residents of Jerusalem are often forced to demolish their own homes and facilities under the threat of hefty fines. If they refuse to do so, they are over-charged with the costs of the demolition of their own facilities. This practice noticeably displays the alignment of all the components of the racist Israeli establishment: courts, local bodies, the police and army forces. It also is a crime the victims of which are forced into committing against themselves.

During the month of November, the number of facilities that the occupation authorities forced their owners to self-demolish reached (5) facilities out of 107 facilities, all of them in the Jerusalem governorate. They consist of (5) houses, including two houses in the town of Jabal Al Mukaber, and a house in the town of Beit Hanina, a house in Sur Baher, and a house in Ras al-Amud, all of which were demolished on the grounds of lack of a permit.

The occupation authorities in the Jabal Mukaber neighborhood in Jerusalem forced the citizen, Aziz Owaisat, to demolish his house himself, after notifying him earlier, in order to avoid paying heavy fines in the event of the demolition. He demolished his house himself, under the pretext of not having a permit.

The occupation authorities in the town of Beit Hanina forced the Nashashibi family to demolish their two-story house themselves, after notifying them earlier, in order to avoid paying heavy fines in case the occupation authorities carry out the demolition process. Muhammad Khaled Rabay'ah, to personally demolish his house, after being notified earlier, in order to avoid paying heavy fines in the event that the occupation authorities carry out the demolition. The construction) consisting of two floors and an area of 350 square meters, after notified earlier, in order to avoid paying heavy fines in the event of the demolition by the occupation authorities, on the pretext of not having a license.
