Monthly Documentation Report on the Israeli Violations against Palestinian Establishments:

Demolishing, Evacuation, Confiscation, and Notifications with Military Orders to be Targeted in the Future.

1-31/7/202



The report is dedicated to documenting the Israeli violations against Palestinian establishments and houses. The violations include demolishing, evacuation, confiscation, and notifications with military orders to be targeted shortly. The report is based on the information and data collected by the team and field researchers of Human Rights and Democracy Media Center- SHAMS, for the period 1- 31/7/2024. The geographical scope of the report is the West Bank, including Jerusalem.



Overall Statistics

During July 2024, SHAMS Center documented targeting 137 Palestinian establishments by demolishing, confiscation, and notifications with demolishing orders.

The major form of violation was demolishing, where 127 establishments were demolished, including 17 within the policy of self-demolishing as the owners decided to demolish the establishments on their own to avoid paying exaggerated financial penalties or being detained till the fine is paid, in case the Israeli authorities did the demolishing. Two of the houses demolished within the policy of self-demolishing are owned by women. In Jabal Al Mukkabber- Jerusalem, the Israeli authorities obligated a Jerusalemite woman named Aida Al Qanbar to demolish her house on her own as she was notified earlier with a demolishing order. Additionally, the Israeli authorities obligated another woman named Latifa Al Whaidi from Ain Al Louza area in Silwan, to demolish her 100 squared meters house on her own as she was also notified with a demolishing order earlier. As stated earlier, the two ladies decided to demolish the establishments on their own to avoid the high financial penalties. The two houses were demolished under the allegation of unlicensed buildings.

As for the notifications, the Israeli authorities notified the owners of 9 establishments (houses, commercial establishments, and seismic Observatory unit) with demolishing orders.

Regarding the confiscated establishments, the Israeli settlers, protected by the Israeli army, confiscated a house in Baten Al Hawa area- Silwan.

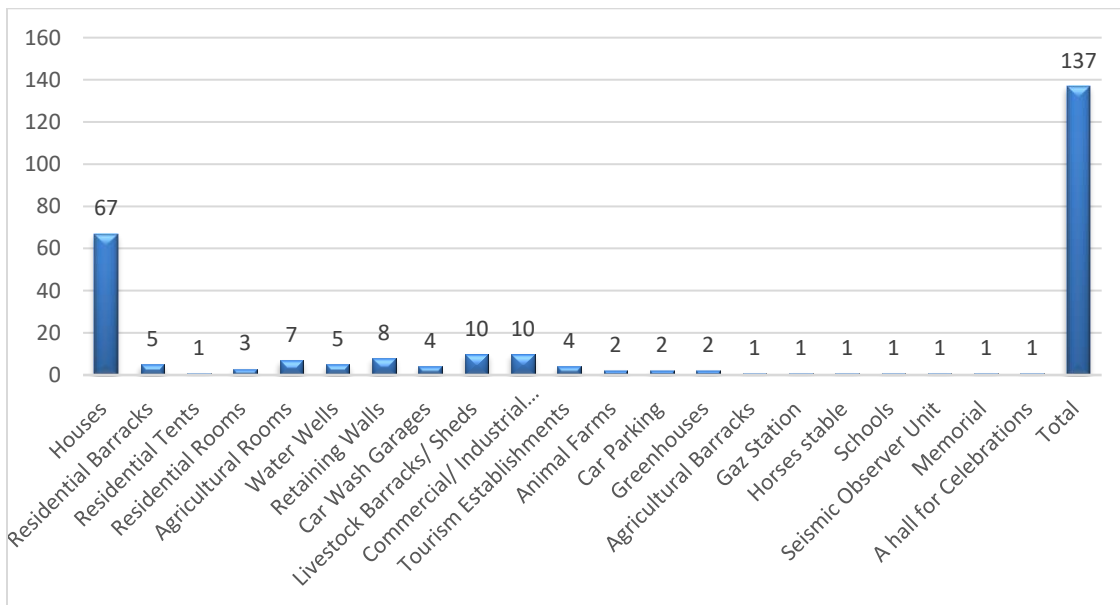

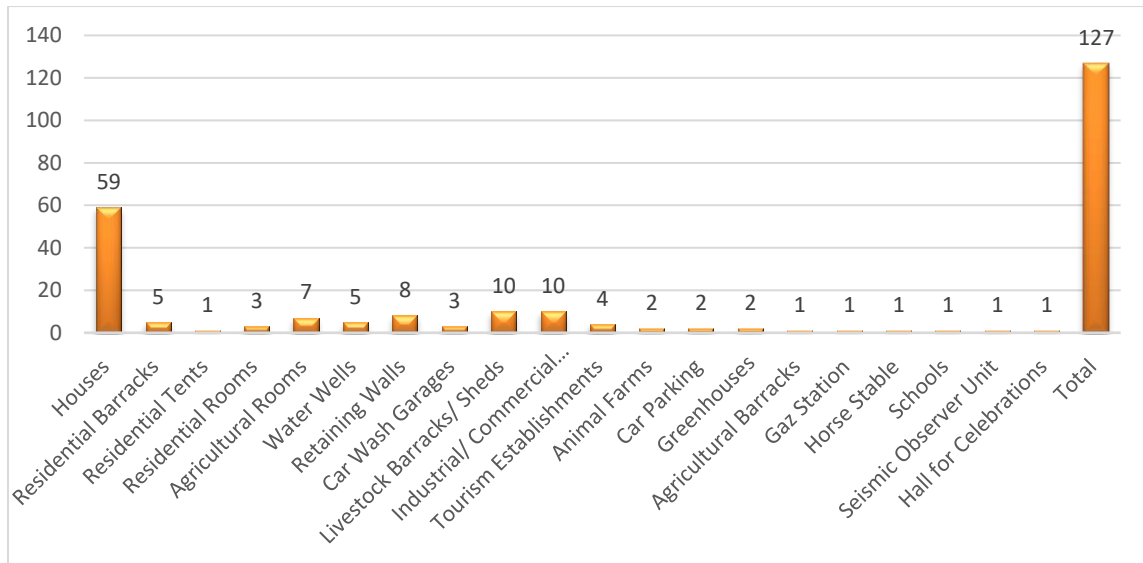

Geographical Distribution of the Targeted Establishments

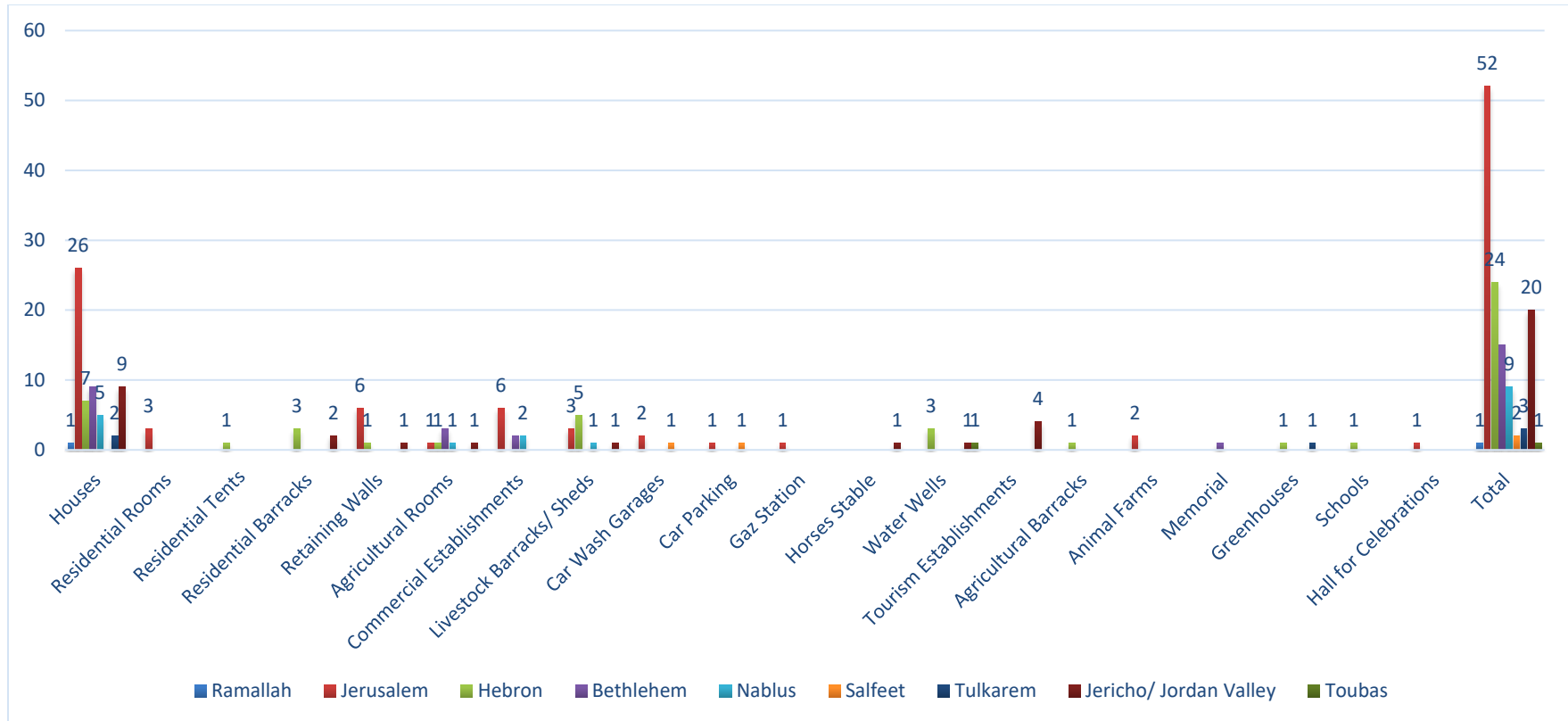
- **Demolished Establishments**

Demolishing and Notifications with Demolishing Orders for Security Reasons:

The Israeli authorities utilize the policy of home demolishing as a tool of collective punishment against Palestinians involved in resisting the occupation and to deter others from being involved in national resistance. In July, the Israeli authorities demolished 3 houses in Ramallah, Jerusalem, and Nablus within this policy. Additionally, a memorial, in Bethlehem, was demolished as well. The table below details the demolished establishments for Security reasons:

Self- Demolishing:

The self-demolishing is a structured oppressive policy applied against Palestinians by the Israeli occupation. Palestinians are obligated to demolish their houses and establishments on their own because if the Israeli authorities accomplish the demolishing, then the owner has to pay the costs of the process as estimated by the occupation. The owner has no choice, either to pay or be detained till the fine is paid. Therefore, Jerusalemites find it cheaper to demolish the establishments on their own. Self-demolishing represents a racist policy in which all the Israeli parties: police, municipality, and judiciary authority are involved. Palestinians are forced to take part in the crimes committed against them.

During July, 17 establishments (out of 127 demolished ones), were within the policy of self-demolishing and were demolished under the allegation of unlicensed building.

Demolishing During Invasions:

While invading the Palestinian cities, towns, villages, and refugee camps, the Israeli forces tend to destroy Palestinians' houses and assets. The Israeli forces usually destroy water, electricity, and sewage networks as well as destroying the streets. In June, the Israeli forces destroyed the following:

Allegations of Violations:

As for the allegations proposed by the Israeli authorities to legalize the crimes against Palestinian establishments, during July, 123 establishments (out of 127 demolished ones), were under the allegation of unlicensed buildings in areas classified as (c). 4 establishments were demolished within the policy of collective punishments against Palestinians involved in resisting the occupation and to deter others from involvement in national resistance.

The Israeli settlers, under the protection of the Israeli army, confiscated a house under the claim that it had been a Jewish property since the year 1881.
